NON INSURED DAMAGES AND POST HIRE CHARGES

Vulnerable Parts & Damages NOT covered by Insurance

The damages below are non-insurable and are NOT included in the Insurance.

NOTE: If new damages are found during the post hire inspection, the charge(s) may be deducted from the security deposit or charged to the credit/debit card details supplied on the Cardholder Authorisation Form, or further terms of payment will be clarified upon invoice.

At commencement of the hire, any pre-existing exterior and interior damages will be recorded for acknowledgement by hirer on the Pre-Hire Vehicle Checklist.

- **Roof damage.** Any damages found to the any part of the vehicle roof section, is not covered by insurance and will be assessed on an individual basis.

- **Windscreen.** Any damage on the windscreen is not covered by insurance and will incur a replacement fee.

- **Wing mirror (casing).** Damage to the wing mirror casing will incur a replacement fee.

- **Wing mirror (glass).** Damage to the wing mirror casing will incur a replacement fee.

- **Exterior running light.** Exterior running light that are missing or damaged will incur a replacement fee.

- **Habitation windows damage.** Cracked or damaged habitation windows will incur a replacement fee per habitation window.

- **Habitation window (scratches).** Scratched or scarred Habitation window will incur a repair fee per window.

- **Habitation body marks (dints, scuffs & light scratches).** Marks to the habitation body will incur repair fee per dint, scuff or scratch.

- **All punctures to the bodywork** will be assessed on an individual basis.

Hirer is liable for the full cost of repair of non-insurable damages.

- **Skylight damage.** Skylight window damage will incur a replacement fee per skylight window

- **Skylight damage.** Skylight window winding mechanism damage will incur a replacement fee per skylight window.

- **Skylight damage.** Skylight window blind damage will incur a replacement fee per skylight window.

- **Light clusters.** Damage to rear Light cluster are subject to a replacement charge

- **Wheel Arch.** Damage to wheel arch will incur a replacement fee.

Any damage to the vehicle or third party property caused through a reversing manoeuvre or replacement or repair of windscreen, tyres, wheels or bike racks will be charged at the full replacement value.

All/any Interior (habitation) damages including:

- 1) Table damage. Damage to the table top, leg or hinge are subject to a replacement table charge.
- 2) Interior lights. Broken or damaged interior lights are subject to a replacement charge per light.
- 3) Interior scrapes and scuffs. Flooring, doors and interior walls found with scuffs or scratches are subject to a repair charge for each.

Other Post hire charges arising

VAT: All post hire charges (including credit card surcharges) are subject to VAT at the prevailing rate of 20%

Payment Processing Fees: All payments made using a credit card incur a payment processing fee of 2.5%.

Smoking: If smoking is suspected upon return of the vehicle, a valet fee of £150.00 applies.

Fresh water tank contamination. In the event of diesel fuel contamination of the fresh water tank, a £1000.00 fixed penalty fee applies.

Non listed damages. Damage found that is not on either the Exterior damages or Interior damages list, will be charged the cost of replacement parts & labour.

Other Post hire outstanding payments.

We require payment to terms. Payment must be made on time, in full, and without any deduction, set off or counterclaim. In the event that an account is outstanding, we will refer the matter to our debt collection agency, which will incur costs of 15% + vat. Any costs incurred to collect the debt will be added to the debt, plus VAT at the prevailing rate.

You agree that you will be legally liable to pay us the above surcharge, and that payment of the same can be enforced against you in court. You also agree to pay interest at the relevant reference rate provided for under the Late Payment of Commercial Debts (Interest) Act 1998, which interest is payable both after and before any judgment of the court and continues to accrue.
